What is it?

Intensive Training in the language and practice of Inter-modal Expressive Arts in Therapy, Coaching, Consulting and Education as preparation for the European Graduate School's Post Master's Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies and PhD Program.

What is the primary purpose?

To increase understanding of the philosophy, theory and practice of intermodal expressive arts therapy taught at the European Graduate School, Saas Fee, Switzerland.

Who is the teacher?

Markus Alexander has been a faculty member of the European Graduate School since 1995. From 1987 to 2003 he was Founder and Director of an Expressive Arts Therapy training program in New York. Now residing and teaching in Edmonton, he currently has established expressive arts training programs there, as well as teaching as adjunct faculty at St. Stephen's College. He has been an International Symposia workshop facilitator annually since 1996, and has taught in numerous countries in Europe, the Middle East and North America for almost fifteen years. Markus has been working and studying, playing with Expressive Arts pioneers Paolo Knill and Steve Levine since 1985.
